Storage and dispensing instructions

Storage instructions

CAELO HV products

(see CAELO assortment and price list - HV products)

Normal storage conditions apply to all CAELO HV products (medicinal products / retail packs); i.e. store or keep at room temperature / not above 25 °C.

CAELO formulation substances (no end-user packaging)

With very few exceptions, normal storage conditions apply to these substances, i.e. store or keep at room temperature / not above 25 °C.

For substances to be stored differently, there is a note on the label of such articles. According to the current status, the following temperature-sensitive products should be mentioned in particular:

Note: These Caelo articles are not articles that require a cold chain. Exceeding the storage temperature for a short time does not affect the quality of the products.

Fatty oils

For this product group we recommend storage **below 20 °C** (cellar or cool room), but not in the refrigerator, as flocculation or clouding can already occur at these temperatures (see CAELO-Info 211: "Fatty oils (extraction, labelling, storage, clouding)").

Storage instructions on storage container:

According to ApBetrO §16, medicinal products, raw materials, medical devices and standard pharmacy goods and test equipment must be stored clearly and in such a way that their quality is not adversely affected and confusion is avoided. If their proper quality has not been established, they must be stored separately and labelled accordingly. The provisions of Gefahrstoffverordnung (GefStoffV), Betäubungsmittelgesetz (BtMG) including the ordinances issued in this regard and the Medical Devices Regulation (MDR) remain unaffected. The storage instructions of the pharmacopoeia must be observed. The storage container for medicinal products and raw materials must be designed in such a way that the quality of the contents is not impaired. They must be labelled in a legible and durable manner that clearly identifies the contents. A common scientific name must be used. The contents must be labelled with additional information if this is necessary to determine the quality and to avoid confusion.



In accordance with Section 8 (2) GefStoffV and TRGS 201, it must be ensured that hazardous substances and mixtures are labelled in-house with sufficient information on classification, handling hazards and the safety measures to be observed; preferably a label that complies with regulation (EC) no. 1272/2008 (CLP regulation) should be selected. Under certain circumstances, storage container can be provided with simplified labelling. The BAK's (Bundesapothekerkammer) suggestions on the "colour concept" for labelling the required personal protective equipment are also recommended. The requirements of TRGS 510 must be observed for the storage of hazardous substances.

Pharmacy obligation or prescription obligation:

All CAELO prescription substances are supplied by us exclusively to commercial users - not to end consumers - where the respective intended use is decided. In the case of medicinal use of such raw materials (e.g. medical prescriptions), the pharmacy must decide on the possible status ("available only in pharmacies", "available only on prescription") of the product ready for dispensing (in some cases also depending on the concentration, etc.).
